9 EXPLANATION

10 Chapter 390 allows cities to jointly own transmission
11 facilities which are located within the state pursuant to
12 an agreement. This bill would allow the cities to also own
13 some facilities which are outside the state provided that
14 some of the joint facilities are located within the state.

15 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OWNERSHIP OF JOINT TRANSMISSION FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 390.1, subsection 10, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

10. ~~"Own-and-ownership"~~ "Own" and "ownership" in the case of transmission facilities, including substations and associated facilities, which are located in whole or in part in Iowa, may include the right to the use of an amount of the capacity ~~thereof~~ of the facilities, if the joint agreement so provides. "Own" and "ownership" in the case of transmission
