12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill requires the local board of health to furnish
14 the state department of health after sixty days of the first
15 day of school evidence that each person enrolled in elementary
16 or secondary school has been immunized. Current law requires
17 the evidence to be submitted to the state department of health
18 within thirty days.

19 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.
