EXPLANATION

10 This bill provides a time limit for seeking judicial re-
11 view of final agency actions of the Iowa civil rights commis-
12 sion which are not of general applicability and are not con-
13 tested case decisions. The time limit is thirty days.

14 The bill takes effect July 1 following enactment.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TIME LIMIT FOR PETITIONING FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A NO-PROBABLE-CAUSE DECISION OF THE IOWA CIVIL RIGHTS COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 601A.17, subsection 1, Code 1983, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. Notwithstanding the time limit provided in section 17A.19, subsection 3, a petition for judicial review of no-probable-cause decisions and other final agency actions which are not of general applicability must
