1 Section 1. Section 422.72, subsection 1, Code 1983, is
2 amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

16 EXPLANATION

17 The bill allows the auditor of state to examine state tax
18 returns and return information to evaluate the department's
19 compliance with state laws. The access is for the purpose
20 of the annual audit required by chapter 11. The information
21 is to remain confidential and could not be released to the
22 public. The bill takes effect upon publication.

AN ACT

TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF REVENUE TO PROVIDE STATE TAX RETURNS AND RETURN INFORMATION TO THE AUDITOR OF STATE FOR AUDITING PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 422.72, subsection 1, Code 1983, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:
NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. The director of revenue shall provide state tax returns and return information to the auditor of state, to the extent that the information is necessary to complete the annual audit of the department of revenue required by section 11.2. The state tax returns and return information provided by the director shall remain confidential and shall not be included in any public documents issued by the auditor of state.

Sec. 2. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect from and after its publication in The Council Bluffs Nonpareil, a newspaper published in Council Bluffs,
