17 EXPLANATION

18 This bill requires senate confirmation for a governor's  
19 appointment to the office of the director of planning and  
20 programming. The director serves at the pleasure of the  
21 governor at a salary fixed by the general assembly. The bill  
22 applies to a vacancy which occurs in the director's position  
23 after the effective date of the bill. This bill takes effect  
24 July 1 following enactment.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPOINTMENT OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND PROGRAMMING

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA

Section 1. Section 7A.1 Code 1981, is amended to read as follows:

7A.1 OFFICE CREATED. There is hereby created the office for planning and programming which shall be directly attached to and a part of the office of the governor. The governor may shall appoint a director of planning and programming ~~and~~ subject to confirmation by the senate. The director shall serve at the pleasure of the governor and receive a salary within the range fixed by the general assembly. The governor may appoint other necessary personnel. Employees of the office shall serve at the pleasure of the governor. ~~Where~~ To the extent required by federal statutes, employees shall be covered under the provisions of chapter 19A.
