1 Section 1. Section 107.24, subsection 11, Code 1983, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 11. Establish a program governing the harvesting and sale
4 of American ginseng subject to the convention on international
5 trade in endangered species of wild fauna and flora and adopt
6 rules providing for the time and conditions for the harvesting
7 of the ginseng, the registration of dealers and exporters,
8 the records kept by dealers and exporters, and the
9 certification of legal taking. The time for harvesting of
10 wild ginseng shall not begin before September 15 or extend
11 beyond November 1.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill requires that the time set by the state
14 conservation commission for the harvesting of wild ginseng
15 not begin before September 15 or extend beyond November 1.
16 The bill takes effect July 1 following enactment.

TO SET THE TIME FOR THE HARVESTING OF WILD GINSENG.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 107.24, subsection 11, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

11. Establish a program governing the harvesting and sale of American ginseng subject to the convention on international trade in endangered species of wild fauna and flora and adopt rules providing for the time and conditions for the harvesting of the ginseng, the registration of dealers and exporters, the records kept by dealers and exporters, and the certification of legal taking.
