SENATE FILE 500  
FISCAL NOTE

REQUESTED BY SENATOR ALVIN MILLER

In compliance with a written request there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate File 500 pursuant to Joint Rule 17.

Senate File 500 is an Act relating to the rate of inspection fees paid on commercial feeds.

Senate File 500 would raise the maximum allowable fee per ton of feed from ten to fifteen cents. In 1982 \$445,992 was collected. If the fee were raised to the new maximum, an additional \$222,196 would be raised and tonage remained constant.

The Department intends to raise the fee by two cents per ton. This would raise an additional \$89,000 per year if tonage remains constant.

There is some drop expected in tonage with an estimated increase in revenue of \$80,000 per year.
