1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 280A.28 TAX FOR EQUIPMENT  
2 REPLACEMENT. Annually, the board of directors may certify  
3 for levy a tax on taxable property in the merged area at a

6 EXPLANATION

7 This bill authorizes boards of directors of area schools  
8 to adopt property tax of three cents per thousand dollars  
9 of assessed value in the merged area for equipment replacement.

10 The bill takes effect July 1 following its enactment.  
11 If enacted by July 1, 1983, the tax could be certified March  
12 15, 1984 and the first collection would be October 1984.

FISCAL NOTE

REQUESTED BY SENATOR BROWN

In compliance with a written request there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for Senate File 537 pursuant to Joint Rule 17.

Senate File 537 is an Act which authorizes boards of directors of area schools to adopt a property tax of three cents per thousand dollars of assessed value in the merged area for equipment replacement.

There would be no state dollars affected by this act; it would all be made up of property tax dollars. For the FY 1983 there was a taxable valuation of \$61,813,334,188. The maximum amount of property tax generated if all schools levied the full three cents per thousand would be:

$$(\$61,813,334,188 / 1000) \times .03 = \$1,854,400$$

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
