1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund
2 of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and
3 ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services
4 for aid to families with dependent children two million nine
5 hundred ninety-eight thousand (2,998,000) dollars, or so much
6 thereof as is necessary, to be used for the same purposes
7 and to supplement funds appropriated by 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter
8 7, section 3, subsection 1, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts,
9 chapter 1260, section 90.

10 Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of
11 the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and
12 ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services
13 for medical assistance five million four hundred twenty
14 thousand (5,420,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is
15 necessary, to be used for the same purposes and to supplement
16 funds appropriated by 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3,
17 subsection 2, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260,
18 sections 94 and 95.

19 Sec. 3. The appropriation from the general fund of the
20 state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and ending
21 June 30, 1983, to the department of social services for
22 contractual services-medical carrier under 1981 Iowa Acts,
23 chapter 7, section 3, subsection 3, as amended by 1982 Iowa
24 Acts, chapter 1260, section 99, is reduced by one hundred
25 eighty thousand (180,000) dollars.

26 Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the general fund of
27 the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and
28 ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services
29 for work and training programs twelve thousand (12,000)
30 dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for
31 the same purposes and to supplement funds appropriated by
32 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3, subsection 4, as amended
33 by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260, section 100.

34 Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the general fund of
35 the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and

1 ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services
2 for state supplementary assistance two hundred twelve thousand
3 (212,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to
4 be used for the same purposes and to supplement funds
5 appropriated by 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3,
6 subsection 6, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260,
7 section 102.

8 Sec. 6. The appropriation from the general fund of the
9 state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and ending
10 June 30, 1983, to the department of social services for foster
11 care under 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3, subsection
12 9, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260, section 104,
13 is reduced by eight hundred thousand (800,000) dollars.

14 Sec. 7. There is appropriated from the general fund of
15 the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and
16 ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services
17 for community-based services seven hundred forty-five thousand
18 (745,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to
19 be used for the same purposes and to supplement funds
20 appropriated by 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3,
21 subsection 10, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260,
22 section 106.

23 Sec. 8. There is appropriated from the general fund of
24 the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and
25 ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services,
26 thirty thousand (30,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is
27 necessary, for the distribution of federal surplus commodities,
28 including salaries and support, maintenance, and miscellaneous
29 purposes.

30 Sec. 9. 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1262, section 14, is
31 amended by adding the following new subsection:

32 NEW SUBSECTION. 4. If the social services block grant
33 funds received from the federal government exceed the amount
34 appropriated in section 5 of this Act, the excess shall be
35 prorated to the appropriate programs according to the per-

1 centages of the funds allocated to the programs by that sec-
2 tion, except excess funds shall not be prorated for adminis-
3 trative expenses. State funds in the same amount as the ex-
4 cess federal social services block grant funds shall revert
5 to the general fund of the state.

6 Sec. 10. There is appropriated from the fund created by
7 section 8.41 to the department of social services for the
8 division of field operations, seven hundred thirty thousand
9 (730,000) dollars for the federal fiscal year beginning October
10 1, 1982, and ending September 30, 1983, to be used for the
11 same purposes and to supplement funds appropriated by 1982
12 Iowa Acts, chapter 1262, section 5, subsection 3, paragraph
13 a. The funds appropriated by this section are the anticipated
14 funds to be received from the federal government pursuant
15 to the federal Emergency Jobs Appropriations Act, Pub. L.
16 No. 98-8. State funds shall not revert to the general fund
17 of the state as a result of the federal funds received under
18 this section, notwithstanding section 8 of this Act.

19 Sec. 11. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance,
20 takes effect from and after its publication in the Storm Lake
21 Pilot-Tribune, a newspaper published in Storm Lake, Iowa,
22 and in the Oskaloosa Daily Herald, a newspaper published in
23 Oskaloosa, Iowa.

24 EXPLANATION

25 This bill supplements the 1982-1983 fiscal year
26 appropriations to the department of social services relating
27 to aid to families with dependent children, medical assistance,
28 work and training programs, state supplementary assistance,
29 and community-based services. The bill reduces departmental
30 appropriations for the same fiscal year for contractual
31 services-medical carrier and foster care. The bill
32 appropriates funds for the distribution of federal surplus
33 commodities.

34 The bill also provides for the allocation of excess federal
35 social services block grant funds to the department of social

1 services and reverts an equal amount of state funds to the
2 state general fund. Federal emergency jobs funds are
3 appropriated to the department for the division of field
4 operations.

5 The bill takes effect upon publication.

AN ACT

RELATING TO ADJUSTMENTS TO APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT
OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR THE STATE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING
JULY 1, 1982 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1983 AND THE FEDERAL
FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1982 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER
30, 1983.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services for aid to families with dependent children two million nine hundred ninety-eight thousand (2,998,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the same purposes and to supplement funds appropriated by 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3, subsection 1, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260, section 90.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services for medical assistance five million four hundred twenty thousand (5,420,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the same purposes and to supplement funds appropriated by 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3, subsection 2, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260, sections 94 and 95.

Sec. 3. The appropriation from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and ending

June 30, 1983, to the department of social services for contractual services-medical carrier under 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3, subsection 3, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260, section 99, is reduced by one hundred eighty thousand (180,000) dollars.

Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services for work and training programs twelve thousand (12,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the same purposes and to supplement funds appropriated by 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3, subsection 4, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260, section 100.

Sec. 5. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services for state supplementary assistance two hundred twelve thousand (212,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the same purposes and to supplement funds appropriated by 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3, subsection 6, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260, section 102.

Sec. 6. The appropriation from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services for foster care under 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3, subsection 9, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260, section 104, is reduced by eight hundred thousand (800,000) dollars.

Sec. 7. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services for community-based services seven hundred forty-five thousand (745,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, to be used for the same purposes and to supplement funds appropriated by 1981 Iowa Acts, chapter 7, section 3,

subsection 10, as amended by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1260, section 106.

Sec. 8. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1982, and ending June 30, 1983, to the department of social services, thirty thousand (30,000) dollars, or so much thereof as is necessary, for the distribution of federal surplus commodities, including salaries and support, maintenance, and miscellaneous purposes.

Sec. 9. 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1262, section 14, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 4. If the social services block grant funds received from the federal government exceed the amount appropriated in section 5 of this Act, the excess shall be prorated to the appropriate programs according to the percentages of the funds allocated to the programs by that section, except excess funds shall not be prorated for administrative expenses. State funds in the same amount as the excess federal social services block grant funds shall revert to the general fund of the state.

Sec. 10. There is appropriated from the fund created by section 8.41 to the department of social services for the division of field operations, seven hundred thirty thousand (730,000) dollars for the federal fiscal year beginning October 1, 1982, and ending September 30, 1983, to be used for the same purposes and to supplement funds appropriated by 1982 Iowa Acts, chapter 1262, section 5, subsection 3, paragraph a. The funds appropriated by this section are the anticipated funds to be received from the federal government pursuant to the federal Emergency Jobs Appropriations Act, Pub. L. No. 98-9. State funds shall not revert to the general fund of the state as a result of the federal funds received under this section, notwithstanding section 9 of this Act.

Sec. 11. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, takes effect from and after its publication in the Storm Lake

Pilot-Tribune, a newspaper published in Storm Lake, Iowa, and in the Oskaloosa Daily Herald, a newspaper published in Oskaloosa, Iowa.
