11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill removes the reference to a minister of the gospel  
13 in the section of law relating to who may solemnize a marriage  
14 and replaces it with the phrase "a person ordained or desig-  
15 nated as a regular leader of the person's denomination".

16 The bill is effective July 1 following enactment.

AN ACT  
SPECIFYING WHO MAY SOLEMNIZE A MARRIAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 595.10, Code 1983, is amended to read as follows:

595.10 WHO MAY SOLEMNIZE. Marriages ~~must~~ may be solemnized by:

1. A judge of the supreme court, court of appeals, or district court, including a district associate judge, or a judicial magistrate.
