17 Buffalo, Iowa beginning on January 2, 1982 and those acts
18 should be legalized and the matter once and for all be put to
19 rest; NOW THEREFORE,

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

21 Section 1. That all proceedings taken by the city council
22 of the city of Buffalo, Iowa to increase the compensation of
23 the mayor effective January 1, 1982 where the city council
24 failed to comply with section 372.13, subsection 8, of the
25 Code are validated, legalized, and confirmed.

26 EXPLANATION

27 The bill legalizes proceedings taken by the city council of
28 the city of Buffalo, Iowa through the adoption of a resolution
29 to increase the compensation of the mayor beginning January 1,
30 1982 in violation of section 372.13, subsection 8, of the

WHEREAS, some doubts have arisen pertaining to the increased compensation paid to the mayors of the city of Buffalo, Iowa beginning on January 1, 1982 and those acts should be legalized and the matter once and for all be put to rest; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That all proceedings taken by the city council of the city of Buffalo, Iowa to increase the compensation of the mayor effective January 1, 1982 where the city council

failed to comply with section 372.13, subsection 8, of the Code are validated, legalized, and confirmed.
