TO EXEMPT AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY VEHICLES FROM THE CHILD RESTRAINT LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.446, subsection 3, Code 1985, is amended to read as follows:

3. This section does not apply to ~~nonresidents-of-iowa-or~~ peace officers acting on official duty. This section also does not apply to the transportation of children in 1965 model year or older vehicles or authorized emergency vehicles. This section does not apply to the transportation of a child who has been certified by a physician licensed under chapter 148, 150, or 150A as having a medical, physical, or mental condition which prevents or makes inadvisable securing the
