12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill authorizes the township clerk to reside within
14 the incorporated area of a township. Currently, all township
15 officers must reside in the township outside the corporate
16 limits of a city located in the township.

AN ACT
RELATING TO THE RESIDENCY OF A TOWNSHIP CLERK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 39.22, Code Supplement 1985, is amended to read as follows:

39.22 TOWNSHIP OFFICERS.

Township trustees and the township clerk, in townships which do not include a city, shall be elected by the voters of the entire township. In townships which include a city, the officers shall be elected by the voters of the township who reside outside the corporate limits of the city and the officers trustees shall reside in the township outside the
