15 EXPLANATION

16 The bill authorizes the transfer of funds from the farm-to-
17 market road fund to the primary road fund to use unobligated
18 funds on highway construction projects. All transfers are
19 subject to approval by the state comptroller and must be
20 repaid.

AN ACT

AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY TRANSFER OF FUNDS BETWEEN THE PRIMARY ROAD FUND AND THE FARM-TO-MARKET ROAD FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 310.27, Code Supplement 1985, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. If in the judgment of the department the anticipated claims against the primary road fund for any month are in excess of moneys available, a temporary transfer for highway construction costs may be made from the farm-to-market road fund to the primary road fund providing there will remain in the transferring fund a sufficient balance to meet the anticipated obligations. All transfers shall be repaid from the primary road fund to the farm-to-market road fund within sixty days from the date of the transfer. A transfer shall be made only with the approval of the state comptroller and shall comply with the state comptroller's rules relating to the transfer of funds. Similar transfers may be made by the department from the primary road fund to the farm-to-market road fund and these transfers shall be subject to the same terms and conditions
