1 Section 1. GENERAL SALARY RANGES -- EXCEPTIONS. The  
2 salary ranges in effect for the fiscal year beginning July 1,  
3 1984, and subsequent fiscal years as provided in 1983 Iowa  
4 Acts, chapter 205, section 7 for appointed nonelected persons  
5 shall apply to all positions held by the appointed nonelected  
6 persons or their successors in the executive branch of state  
7 government for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1986, except  
8 for the following:

9 1. Department directors whose salary ranges are specified  
10 in section 2 of this Act.

11 2. Full-time members of the state board of parole who  
12 shall be compensated within salary range 4.

13 3. The industrial commissioner who shall be compensated

13 of this Act and in 1983 Iowa Acts, chapter 205, section 7  
14 within the salary ranges provided for the positions. The  
15 conditions and considerations specified in 1983 Iowa Acts,  
16 chapter 205, section 6 shall apply when individual salaries  
17 are established and to the appointed nonelected incumbents  
18 receiving the salaries.

19 Sec. 4. APPROPRIATIONS. All statutory salaries  
20 established by the governor or as otherwise provided by law  
21 shall be paid from the appropriations made to the departments.

3 journals of the house and senate, except that ~~in-the-event~~ if  
4 the length of the first regular session of the general

7 expense payments shall be made only for one hundred ten  
8 calendar days for the first session and one hundred calendar  
9 days for the second session. However, members from Polk  
6 10 county shall receive ~~twenty-five~~ thirty-five dollars per day.  
11 Travel expenses shall be paid at the rate established by  
12 section 18.117 for actual travel in going to and returning  
13 from the seat of government by the nearest traveled route for  
14 not more than one time per week during a legislative session.  
15 However, any increase ~~from-time-to-time~~ in the mileage rate  
16 established by section 18.117 shall not become effective for  
17 members of the general assembly until the convening of the  
18 next general assembly following the session in which the  
19 increase is adopted; and this provision shall prevail over any  
20 inconsistent provision of any present or future statute.

25 EXPLANATION

26 This bill establishes three salary ranges for department  
27 directors for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1986, and for  
28 subsequent fiscal years. Positions which are not included in  
29 the list of department directors are to continue to be com-  
30 pensated within the salary ranges which have been in effect  
31 since July 1, 1984. However, the full-time members of the  
32 board of parole are changed from salary range 1 to salary  
33 range 4 and the industrial commissioner is changed from salary  
34 range 3 to salary range 4. These salary ranges are specified  
35 in 1983 Iowa Acts, chapter 205, section 7.

1 This bill also increases the expense of office for members  
2 of the general assembly by ten dollars per diem for one  
3 hundred ten days of the first regular session and one hundred  
4 days of the second regular session. The increase takes effect  
5 in January 1987.

6 The bill also repeals 1985 Iowa Acts, chapter 253, section  
7 1, which freezes the salaries of appointed nonelected public  
8 officials set by the governor in the executive department at  
9 the salary level received as of January 1, 1985.

AN ACT

RELATING TO COMPENSATION FOR DEPARTMENT DIRECTORS AND OTHER PUBLIC OFFICIALS BY SPECIFYING SALARY RANGES, PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION ADJUSTMENTS, AND MAKING CORRESPONDING AMENDMENTS TO THE CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. GENERAL SALARY RANGES -- EXCEPTIONS. The salary ranges in effect for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1984, and subsequent fiscal years as provided in 1983 Iowa Acts, chapter 205, section 7 for appointed nonelected persons shall apply to all positions held by the appointed nonelected persons or their successors in the executive branch of state government for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1986, except for the following:

- 1. Department directors whose salary ranges are specified in section 2 of this Act.
- 2. Full-time members of the state board of parole who shall be compensated within salary range 4.
- 3. The industrial commissioner who shall be compensated within salary range 4.
- 4. The members of the employment appeal board who shall be compensated within salary range 3.

The salary ranges referred to in subsections 2 through 4 mean the salary ranges specified in 1983 Iowa Acts, chapter 205, section 7.

Sec. 2. DEPARTMENTAL DIRECTOR'S SALARY RANGES.

1. The salary ranges for department directors are effective for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1986, and the salary ranges shall remain in effect until otherwise provided by law:

2. The following are department director's salary range 1 positions: department of inspections and appeals, and department of human rights.

3. The following are department director's range 2 positions: department of cultural affairs, department of elder affairs, department of general services, department of public safety, department of public health, department of personnel, department of commerce, department of corrections, and department of employment services.

4. The following are department director's range 3 positions: department of management, department of education, department of revenue and finance, department of economic development, department of human services, department of transportation, executive secretary of the state board of regents, and department of natural resources.

Sec. 3. COMPENSATION ADJUSTMENTS. Except as otherwise provided by law, the governor shall establish a salary for appointed nonelected persons in the executive branch of state government holding a position enumerated in sections 1 and 2 of this Act and in 1983 Iowa Acts, chapter 205, section 7 within the salary ranges provided for the positions. The conditions and considerations specified in 1983 Iowa Act's, chapter 205, section 6 shall apply when individual salaries are established and to the appointed nonelected incumbents receiving the salaries.

Sec. 4. APPROPRIATIONS. All statutory salaries established by the governor or as otherwise provided by law shall be paid from the appropriations made to the departments.

Sec. 5. Section 14.13, subsection 1, paragraphs c and d, Code Supplement 1985, are amended to read as follows:

c. Correct internal references to sections which are cited erroneously or have been repealed, and names of agencies, officers, or other entities which have been changed, when there appears to be no doubt as to the proper methods of making the corrections. The Code editor shall ~~compile-a-list~~ maintain a record of the corrections made under this paragraph ~~in-Code-editor's-notes-to-the-edition-of-the-Code-in-which-the-corrections-are-made.~~ This list The record shall be available to the public.

d. Transpose sections or divide sections so as to give to distinct subject matters a section number but without changing the meaning and add or amend headnotes to sections and subsections. Pursuant to section 3.3, the headnotes are not part of the law.

Sec. 6. Section 14.13, subsections 2 and 3, Code Supplement 1985, are amended to read as follows:

The Code editor or designee shall seek direction from the senate committee on judiciary and the house committee on judiciary and law enforcement when making any Code changes, and from the administrative rules review committee and the administrative rules coordinator when making Iowa administrative code changes, which appear to require substantial editing and which might otherwise be interpreted to exceed the scope of the Code editor's authority. The Code editor or designee shall maintain a record of the changes made under this subsection. The record shall be available to the public.

3. The effective date of all editorial changes in an edition of the Code or supplement to the Code is the date the legislative council approves the printing contract for publication of that edition or supplement. The effective date of all editorial changes for the Iowa administrative code is the date those changes are published in the Iowa administrative code.

Sec. 7. REPEALER. 1985 Iowa Acts, chapter 253, section 1 is repealed.
