1 Section 1. Section 89.7, subsections 1 and 3, Code 1985,  
2 are amended to read as follows:

3 1. The inspection required by this chapter shall not be  
4 made by the commissioner ~~where-any~~ if an owner or user of any  
5 equipment specified by this chapter obtains an inspection by a  
6 representative of a reputable insurance company and obtains a  
7 policy of insurance upon the equipment from that insurance  
8 company. The representative conducting the inspection shall  
9 be commissioned by the commissioner as a special inspector for  
10 the year during which the inspection occurs and shall meet  
11 such other requirements as the commissioner may by rule  
12 establish. The commission shall be valid for one year and the

FISCAL NOTE

REQUESTED BY REPRESENTATIVE PEICK

In compliance with a written request received March 1, 1985, a fiscal note for HOUSE FILE 359 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note are available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

House File 359 authorizes the Labor Commissioner to establish fees for boiler inspections and for insurance companies authorized to perform boiler inspections.

FISCAL EFFECT: House File 359 would make the boiler inspection division self-supporting by increasing boiler inspection fees. The fees are deposited in the state general fund. The fiscal effect is as follows:

RELATING TO FEES FOR BOILER INSPECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 89.7, subsections 1 and 3, Code 1985, are amended to read as follows:

1. The inspection required by this chapter shall not be made by the commissioner where any if an owner or user of any equipment specified by this chapter obtains an inspection by a representative of a reputable insurance company and obtains a policy of insurance upon the equipment from that insurance company. The representative conducting the inspection shall be commissioned by the commissioner as a special inspector for the year during which the inspection occurs and shall meet such other requirements as the commissioner may by rule establish. The commission shall be valid for one year and the special inspector shall pay a ten-dollar fee for the issuance of the commission. The commissioner shall establish the amount of the fee by rule.

3. Upon such showing and the payment of a fee of five dollars-for-each-one-year-inspection-and-ten-dollars-for-each two-year-inspection, the commissioner shall issue a certificate of inspection by the bureau of labor, which shall be valid only for the period specified in section 89.3. The commissioner shall establish the amount of the fee by rule.

Sec. 2. Section 89.8, Code 1985, is amended by striking the section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

89.8 FEES FOR INSPECTION.

The commissioner shall adopt rules to charge and collect fees for inspection of boilers and pressure units by the boiler inspector. Fees may be set by rule not more than once each year. Fees established by the commissioner shall be

based upon the costs of administering the provisions of this chapter, and shall give due regard to the time spent by bureau of labor personnel in performing duties, and to any travel expenses incurred.
