27 EXPLANATION

28 Section 321.40 currently requires the clerk of court in
29 counties with a population of at least 200,000 and in counties
30 which have adopted the provisions of this section by resolu-
31 tion, to notify the county treasurer of outstanding warrants
32 by December 1 of each year. This bill requires the clerk of
33 court to notify the county treasurer by the first day of each
34 month. The change is to bring this section in line with
35 Iowa's staggered motor vehicle registration.

REQUIRING MONTHLY NOTIFICATION TO THE COUNTY TREASURER OF OUT-
STANDING ARREST WARRANTS FOR CERTAIN OFFENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.40, unnumbered paragraph 3, Code 1985, is amended to read as follows:

The county treasurer shall refuse to renew the registration of a vehicle registered to a person when notified that there is a warrant outstanding for that person's arrest out of a court located within that county and the warrant arises out of the alleged violation of a provision of this chapter or of an ordinance adopted by a local authority relating to the stopping, parking or operation of a vehicle or the regulation of traffic. Each clerk of court in this state shall, by ~~December 1~~ by the last day of each year month, submit to notify the county treasurer of that county ~~an~~ an-alphabetized ~~list~~ of all persons against whom such an arrest warrant has been issued and is outstanding. Immediately upon the cancellation or satisfaction of such an arrest warrant the clerk of court shall notify the person against whom the arrest warrant was issued and the county treasurer if that person's name appeared on the last list furnished to the county treasurer.
