21 appointment. The board of supervisors shall fix the
22 compensation of the county weed commissioner and deputies. In
23 addition to compensation, the commissioner and deputies shall
3384 24 be paid their necessary travel expenses.

25 EXPLANATION

26 This bill provides that a weed commissioner or deputy weed
27 commissioner must pass the minimum standards established by
28 the department of agriculture for weed identification and the
29 recognized methods for weed control and elimination.

Section 1. Section 317.3, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code
1985, is amended to read as follows:

The board of supervisors of each county shall annually
appoint a county weed commissioner who may be a person
otherwise employed by the county and who ~~is familiar with the~~
various types of weeds passes minimum standards established by
the department of agriculture for noxious weed identification
and the recognized methods for their noxious weed control and
elimination. The county weed commissioner's appointment shall
be effective as of March 1 and shall continue for a term of
one year at the discretion of the board of supervisors unless
the commissioner is removed from office as provided for by
law. The county weed commissioner may, with the approval of
the board of supervisors, require that commercial applicators
and their appropriate employees pass the same standards for
noxious weed identification as established by the department
of agriculture. The name and address of the person appointed
as county weed commissioner shall be certified to the county
auditor and to the secretary of agriculture within ten days of
the appointment. The board of supervisors shall fix the
compensation of the county weed commissioner and deputies. In
addition to compensation, the commissioner and deputies shall
be paid their necessary travel expenses. At the discretion of
the board of supervisors, the weed commissioner shall attend a
seminar or school conducted or approved by the state
