1 Section 1. Section 308.4, subsection 3, Code 1985, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 3. There is appropriated from the general fund of the  
4 state to the state department of transportation the sum of one  
5 hundred thousand dollars for each fiscal year beginning July  
6 1, 1983, and ending June 30, 1988. The money is to be  
7 utilized for the acquisition and construction of highway-  
8 associated project components for any portion of the great  
9 river road, regardless of jurisdiction. Each annual  
10 appropriation shall first be used to reimburse the great river  
11 road fund established in section 312.2, with remaining funds  
12 being available for a period of one fiscal year following the  
13 year of appropriation. The state department of  
14 transportation, in co-operation with the state conservation  
15 commission and the Mississippi river parkway commission, shall  
16 administer this subsection and shall issue rules for  
17 administration in accordance with chapter 17A. A report shall  
18 be submitted listing the expenditures for the previous year  
19 and cumulative expenditures of all funds appropriated by this  
20 section and the report shall be incorporated in the annual  
21 report required by section 17.9.

22 Sec. 2. Section 308.5, Code 1985, is amended to read as

24 308.5 JURISDICTION AND CONTROL.

25 Jurisdiction and control of the great river road ~~shall be~~

28 EXPLANATION

29 Section 1 of this bill clarifies that the standing  
30 appropriation for acquisition and construction of highway-  
31 associated project components for the great river road may be  
32 spent for any portion of the great river road regardless of  
33 jurisdiction.

34 Section 2 of this bill provides that the jurisdiction and  
35 control of the great river road shall be vested the same as

1 other roads in the state. Thus the jurisdiction for portions  
2 of the great river road shall depend upon its functional  
3 classification and road system classification under sections  
4 306.1 and 306.3 and jurisdiction is vested as provided in  
5 section 306.4.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JURISDICTION AND CONTROL OF THE GREAT RIVER ROAD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 308.4, subsection 3, Code 1985, is amended to read as follows:

3. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the state department of transportation the sum of one hundred thousand dollars for each fiscal year beginning July 1, 1983, and ending June 30, 1988. The money is to be utilized for the acquisition and construction of highway-associated project components for any portion of the great river road, regardless of jurisdiction. Each annual appropriation shall first be used to reimburse the great river road fund established in section 312.2, with remaining funds being available for a period of one fiscal year following the year of appropriation. The state department of transportation, in co-operation with the state conservation commission and the Mississippi river parkway commission, shall administer this subsection and shall issue rules for administration in accordance with chapter 17A. A report shall be submitted listing the expenditures for the previous year and cumulative expenditures of all funds appropriated by this section and the report shall be incorporated in the annual report required by section 17.9.

Sec. 2. Section 308.5, Code 1985, is amended to read as follows:

308.5 JURISDICTION AND CONTROL.

Jurisdiction and control of the great river road shall be is vested in the state transportation commission as provided in section 306.4.
