12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill authorizes the board of supervisors to appoint a  
14 permanent clerk to serve the board in lieu of the auditor or  
15 the auditor's designee as clerk. If a permanent clerk or  
16 temporary clerk is used by the board, the permanent or  
17 temporary clerk must provide the auditor with the information  
18 necessary for the auditor to carry out the auditor's duties on  
19 behalf of the board as provided in section 331.504.
