1 Section 1. Section 358B.16, unnumbered paragraph 4, Code  
2 1985, is amended to read as follows:

3 A county library district may be terminated upon if a  
4 majority vote of the electors of the unincorporated area of  
5 the county and the cities included in the county library  
6 district voting on the issue favor the termination. The  
7 election shall be held upon motion of the board of supervisors  
8 and simultaneously with a primary, general, or other county  
9 election. If the vote favors termination, the termination  
10 shall be effective on the succeeding July 1.

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill provides that to terminate a county library dis-  
13 trict, the proposition must be favored by a majority of the  
14 voters voting on the proposition. The bill provides that the  
15 election shall be held at a primary, general, or other county  
16 election. The termination is effective on the succeeding July  
17 1.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TERMINATION OF A COUNTY LIBRARY DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 358B.16, unnumbered paragraph 4, Code 1985, is amended to read as follows:

A county library district may be terminated upon if a majority vote of the electors of the unincorporated area of the county and the cities included in the county library district voting on the issue favor the termination. The election shall be held upon motion of the board of supervisors and simultaneously with a primary, general, or other county
