RELATING TO THE HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS INTERAGENCY COORDINATING COUNCIL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 455D.16, subsection 1, Code 1985, is amended to read as follows:

1. A hazardous chemicals information interagency coordinating council is created. The council shall be organized under chapter 28E. The council is composed of three voting members consisting of the designee of the commissioner of public health, the designee of the labor commissioner, and the designee of the executive director of the department of water, air and waste management. There are five six nonvoting advisory members consisting of the designee of the director of the office of disaster services, the designee of the chief officer of the division of fire protection of the department of public safety, the designee of the head of the state hygienic laboratory, a person representing business and industry, and a person representing labor, and a person
