1 Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of  
2 the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1985 and  
3 ending June 30, 1986 to the Iowa beer and liquor control  
4 department the sum of four hundred eighty-nine thousand  
5 (489,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for  
6 salaries, support, maintenance and other operational purposes.  
7 This appropriation is in addition to any other appropriation  
8 made to the Iowa beer and liquor control department for the  
9 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1985 and ending June 30, 1986.

10 Sec. 2. Section 509A.5, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1985,  
11 is amended to read as follows:

12 Any interest earnings from investments or time deposits of  
13 the funds under the control of the state executive council and  
14 ~~deposited in the health insurance premium operating fund, the~~  
15 ~~health insurance premium reserve fund, and the life insurance~~  
16 ~~premium operating fund used for the payment of health and life~~  
17 ~~insurance premiums~~ shall be deposited to the credit of these  
18 funds.

19 EXPLANATION

20 Section 1 of the bill appropriates \$489,000 in additional  
21 funds to the Iowa beer and liquor control department for the  
22 1985-1986 fiscal year for salaries, support, maintenance and  
23 other operational purposes.

24 Section 2 of this bill allows interest earned from the  
25 investment of all employee insurance funds under the control  
26 of the executive council to be credited to the deposit of the  
27 funds. Currently, only the health insurance premium operating  
28 fund, the health insurance premium reserve fund, and the life  
29 insurance premium operating fund, can earn their own interest.

AN ACT

RELATING TO CERTAIN STATE FUNDS BY MAKING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO THE IOWA BEER AND LIQUOR CONTROL DEPARTMENT AND ALLOWING INTEREST FROM THE INVESTMENT OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEE INSURANCE FUNDS TO BE DEPOSITED TO THOSE FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1985 and ending June 30, 1986 to the Iowa beer and liquor control department the sum of three hundred nine thousand (309,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for salaries, support, maintenance and other operational purposes. This appropriation is in addition to any other appropriation made to the Iowa beer and liquor control department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1985 and ending June 30, 1986.

Sec. 2. Section 509A.5, unnumbered paragraph 2, Code 1985, is amended to read as follows:

Any interest earnings from investments or time deposits of the funds under the control of the state executive council and deposited-in-the-health-insurance-premium-operating-fund; the health-insurance-premium-reserve-fund; and-the-life-insurance premium-operating-fund-used-for-the-payment-of-health-and-life
