RELATING TO THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS FOR THE ELIMINATION OF ASBESTOS FROM SCHOOL BUILDINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 279.43, subsection 1, Code 1985, is amended to read as follows:

The board of directors may pay the actual cost of removal or encapsulation of asbestos existing in its school buildings from any funds in the general fund of the district, funds received from the schoolhouse tax authorized under section 278.1, subsection 1, or funds from the tax levy certified under section 297.5 or moneys obtained through a
