AN ACT

RELATING TO THE TIME PERIOD WHEN VOLUNTEER FIRE FIGHTERS ARE ACTING IN THE COURSE OF EMPLOYMENT FOR PURPOSES OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION BENEFITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 85.61, subsection 6, Code 1985, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. Personal injuries sustained by a volunteer fire fighter arise in the course of employment if the injuries are sustained at any time from the time the volunteer fire fighter is summoned to duty as a volunteer fire fighter until the time the volunteer fire fighter is
