1 Section 1. NEW SECTION. 476.65 RESIDENTIAL ENERGY
2 AUDITS.

3 1. A customer for whom a public utility has performed a
4 residential energy audit under the I-SAVE program shall in
5 writing designate one of the following:

6 a. That the results of the audit shall not be disclosed to
7 any other person, except as permitted in subsection 2.

8 b. That the results of the audit are available to any
9 person engaged in the business of making or providing energy
10 conservation improvements or services who requests the infor-
11 mation whether the request is made for the customer
12 individually or the request is made for the customer as a
13 class.

14 2. The results of an audit conducted under the I-SAVE
15 program shall be made available, upon request, to a person who
16 is a prospective purchaser of the residence. A person who
17 obtains the results of an audit under this subsection shall
18 not use the results for any business purpose.

19 3. The public utility shall make results of the
20 residential energy audits available consistent with this
21 section.

22 4. As used in this section, "I-SAVE program" means the
23 Iowa-Save America's Vital Energy program operated pursuant to
24 rules adopted by the commission.

25 EXPLANATION

26 This bill provides that a customer of a residential energy
27 audit under the I-SAVE program is to designate whether the
28 results of the audit are not to be disclosed to any other
29 person except a prospective purchaser or whether they can be
30 disclosed to any person in the energy conservation business
31 who requests the information. In addition, the results are to
32 be made available to any person who is a prospective purchaser
33 of the residence.

RELATING TO ACCESS TO THE RESULTS OF ENERGY AUDITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. NEW SECTION. 476.65 ENERGY AUDITS.

1. A customer for whom a public utility has performed an energy audit under the I-SAVE program or the CACS program shall in writing designate one of the following:

a. That the results of the audit shall not be disclosed to any other person, except as permitted in subsection 2.

b. That the results of the audit are available to any person engaged in the business of making or providing energy conservation improvements or services who requests the information whether the request is made for the customer individually or the request is made for the customer as a class.

2. The results of an audit conducted under the I-SAVE program or the CACS program shall be made available, upon request, to a person who states in writing that he or she is a prospective purchaser of the facility audited.

3. The public utility shall make results of the energy audits available consistent with this section.

4. As used in this section:

a. "I-SAVE program" means the Iowa-Save America's Vital Energy program operated pursuant to rules adopted by the commission.
