A BILL FOR

1 An Act relating to agencies authorized to receive information
2 pertaining to arson investigations.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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S.F. 2222

1 Section 1. Section 100A.1, subsection 1, Code 1985, is
2 amended by adding the following new lettered paragraphs:

3 NEW LETTERED PARAGRAPH. g. The fire chief of the city in
4 which the fire occurs.

5 NEW LETTERED PARAGRAPH. h. The police chief of the city
6 in which the fire occurs.

7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill provides that the fire chief and police chief of
9 a city in which a fire occurs are "authorized agencies" for
10 purposes of receiving information, including insurance
11 information, relating to arson.
