AN ACT

PROHIBITING POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS OR AGENCIES OF THIS STATE FROM REQUIRING THEIR EMPLOYED PEACE OFFICERS TO ISSUE A CERTAIN NUMBER OF CITATIONS OR MEMORANDUMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:
