RELATING TO THE FINAL REPORT OF A PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE IN PROBATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 633.477, subsection 9, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

9. An accounting of all the moneys and personal property coming into the hands of the personal representative and a detailed accounting of all cash receipts and disbursements.
