26 EXPLANATION

27 This bill strikes the provision that the deputy director of
28 the department of public health responsible for the substance
29 abuse program serves at the pleasure of the director of the
30 department of public health so that this deputy director
31 position is similar to the other deputy director positions
32 within the department of public health.

33 The bill specifies that the state board of health approves
34 all rules related to standards for hospitals, health care
35 facilities, and hospices prior to their adoption by the

1 department of inspections and appeals. Administration of
2 chapters 135B and 135C, and licensure of hospitals, health
3 care facilities, and hospices are stricken from the duties of
4 the Iowa department of public health.
