2 1987, is amended by striking the unnumbered paragraph.

3 EXPLANATION

4 This bill deletes a paragraph of the Code that requires  
5 that individuals who borrow library materials or equipment  
6 having a value of five hundred dollars or more from a library  
7 must leave a deposit and sign a written agreement with the  
8 library. The written agreement must specify the due date, the  
9 amount of the deposit, and the penalty for failure to return  
10 the materials or equipment as agreed.
