3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 207

1 Section 1. Section 125.21, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code
2 1987, is amended to read as follows:

3 The commission has exclusive power in this state to approve
4 and license chemical substitutes and antagonists programs, and
5 monitor chemical substitutes and antagonists programs to
6 ensure that the programs are operating within the rules
7 established pursuant to this chapter. The commission shall
8 grant approval and license if the requirements of the rules
9 are met and no state funding is requested. This section ~~does~~

11 substitutes and antagonists programs conducted by persons
12 exempt from the licensing requirements of this chapter by
13 section 125.13, subsection 2.

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill requires the approval of chemical substitutes and
16 antagonists programs conducted by persons otherwise exempted
17 from the licensing requirements of chapter 125, under the
18 division of substance abuse within the department of public
19 health. Those presently exempted from the licensure
20 requirement but who would now be required to receive approval
21 of these programs include but are not limited to licensed
22 hospitals, certain practitioners of medicine and surgery or
23 osteopathic medicine and surgery, certain private institutions
24 offering substance abuse treatment, alcoholics anonymous, and
25 voluntary nonprofit groups not funded by tax sources.

Section 1. Section 125.21, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

The commission has exclusive power in this state to approve and license chemical substitutes and antagonists programs, and monitor chemical substitutes and antagonists programs to ensure that the programs are operating within the rules established pursuant to this chapter. The commission shall grant approval and license if the requirements of the rules are met and no state funding is requested. This section does not-require requires approval or-licensing of chemical substitutes and antagonists programs conducted by persons
