ALLOWING CERTAIN NAME CHANGES ON AN APPLICATION FOR MARRIAGE OR IN DIVORCE AND ANNULMENT DECREES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 595.5, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

595.5 SURNAME ADOPTED.

Woon-marriage-either A party may request on the application for a marriage license a name change to that of the other party or to some other surname mutually agreed upon by the parties. The names used on the marriage license shall become the legal names of the parties to the marriage. The marriage license shall contain a statement that when a name change is requested and affixed to the marriage license, the new name is the legal name of the requesting party. If a party requests a name change, other than a change of surname to that of the other spouse or to a hyphenated combination of the surnames of both spouses, the party shall request approval of the court pursuant to chapter 674 and shall submit to the court the information required by section 674.27-and-upon. An individual can shall have only one legal name at any one time.
