2 amended to read as follows:

3 2. Dealers may, in addition to other provisions of this
4 section, purchase from the department in-transit stickers, for
5 which a fee of two dollars per sticker shall be paid at time
6 of purchase. One such sticker shall be displayed on each
7 vehicle purchased from a dealer by a nonresident for removal
8 to the state of the nonresident's residence, and one such
9 sticker shall also be displayed on each vehicle not currently
10 registered in Iowa and purchased by an Iowa dealer for removal
11 to the dealer's place of business in this state. The stickers
12 shall be void three fifteen days after issuance by the selling
13 dealer. Each sticker shall contain the following information:

- 14 a. The words "in-transit" in bold type.
- 15 b. The dealer's license number.
- 16 c. The date issued.
- 17 d. The purchaser's name and address.
- 18 e. The word "Iowa" in bold type.
- 19 f. The words "good for three fifteen days after the date
20 of issuance".
- 21 g. Other information the director requires.

22 This information shall be on the gummed side of the sticker
23 and the sticker shall be made of a type of material which is
24 self-destructive when the sticker is removed. The sales
25 invoice verifying the sale shall be in the possession of the
26 driver of the vehicle in transit and shall be signed by the
27 owner or an authorized individual of the issuing dealership.

28 Motor vehicles brought into the state on a transit sticker
29 for the purpose of installation of special equipment may also
30 be subject to the provisions of this subsection.

31 EXPLANATION

32 Presently, an in-transit sticker on a vehicle is valid for
33 a period of three days. The bill changes the period from
34 three days to fifteen days.

TO INCREASE THE TIME PERIOD FOR WHICH IN-TRANSIT STICKERS
ARE VALID.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.109, subsection 2, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

2. Dealers may, in addition to other provisions of this section, purchase from the department in-transit stickers, for which a fee of two dollars per sticker shall be paid at time of purchase. One such sticker shall be displayed on each vehicle purchased from a dealer by a nonresident for removal to the state of the nonresident's residence, and one such sticker shall also be displayed on each vehicle not currently registered in Iowa and purchased by an Iowa dealer for removal to the dealer's place of business in this state. The stickers shall be void three fifteen days after issuance by the selling dealer. Each sticker shall contain the following information:

- a. The words "in-transit" in bold type.
- b. The dealer's license number.
- c. The date issued.
- d. The purchaser's name and address.
- e. The word "Iowa" in bold type.
- f. The words "good for three fifteen days after the date of issuance".
- g. Other information the director requires.

This information shall be on the gummed side of the sticker and the sticker shall be made of a type of material which is self-destructive when the sticker is removed. The sales invoice verifying the sale shall be in the possession of the driver of the vehicle in transit and shall be signed by the owner or an authorized individual of the issuing dealership.

Motor vehicles brought into the state on a transit sticker for the purpose of installation of special equipment may also be subject to the provisions of this subsection.
