EXPLANATION

This bill allows a school district reorganizing on or after July 1, 1988, to use as its budget enrollment the combined budget enrollments of the districts that were involved in the reorganization as if those districts had not reorganized, minus pupils residing in territory not included in the reorganized district during its first budget year.

In compliance with a written request received January 26, 1988, a fiscal note for HOUSE FILE 2226 is hereby submitted pursuant to Joint Rule 17. Data used in developing this fiscal note are available from the Legislative Fiscal Bureau to members of the Legislature upon request.

House file 2226 allows reorganized school districts to calculate their budget enrollment as if the districts had not reorganized. Under current law, the budget enrollment of school districts is calculated as follows. The September 1978 certified headcount is used to calculate 25 percent of the budget enrollment, and the larger of the basic enrollment or the prior year's basic enrollment is used to calculate 75 percent of the budget enrollment, unless the basic enrollment is larger than the calculated budget enrollment. A school district is also guaranteed 101.5% of it's previous year's regular program cost by adding to the budget enrollment a sufficient number to guarantee that amount.

Under the proposal, if a reorganized school district's budget enrollment, when calculated as if the districts involved had not reorganized, is greater than the reorganized budget enrollment, the district may use the former in the first year following the reorganization only. Pupils residing in territory that was severed from the districts involved in the reorganization are not counted in the basic enrollment under this proposal. The proposal is effective for reorganizations occurring on or before July 1, 1988.

Assumptions

- 1. Two reorganizations will occur per year.
- 2. A larger than customary increase in budget enrollment will occur under the proposal for the Okoboji reorganization.
- 3. Other reorganizations will be more routine.

Fiscal Effect:

The proposal would provide an additional incentive to reorganize primarily in situations where a district experiencing rapidly declining enrollment merges with a district experiencing rapid growth. Based on the above assumptions, the provision would result in the following net increase in state aid to school districts:

NEW SUBSECTION. 7. Notwithstanding the procedure prescribed for the calculation of budget enrollment under subsections 3 and 5, if during the first budget year following the effective date of a school district reorganization, a reorganized school district's budget enrollment is less than the combined total of the budget enrollments of the districts involved in the reorganization calculated as if the school districts had not reorganized for that budget year, the budget encollment of the reorganized district shall be calculated under this subsection for that budget year. The budget enrollment is the total of the budget enrollments of the districts involved in the reorganization calculated as if those districts had not reorganized minus the number of pupils residing in territory not included in the reorganized school district. For the purpose of this section, a reorganized school district is one in which the reorganization was approved in an election pursuant to sections 275.18 and 275.20 and will take effect on or after July 1, 1988.

Sec. 2. If the effective date of a school district reorganization is July 1, 1988, and the reorganized school district's budget enrollment is not calculated pursuant to section 1 of this Act for the budget year beginning July 1, 1988, then the budget enrollment shall be calculated pursuant to section 1 of this Act for the budget year beginning July 1, 1989.
