AN ACT

TO PERMIT PERSONS WHO REBUILD MOTOR VEHICLES INTO EMERGENCY VEHICLES TO BE LICENSED AS WHOLESALERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 321.1, Code Supplement 1987, is amended by adding the following new subsections:

<u>NEW SUBSECTION</u>. 87. "Rescue vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is equipped with rescue, fire, or life support equipment used to assist and rescue persons in emergencies or support emergency personnel in the performance of their duties.

NEW SUBSECTION. 88. "Fire vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is equipped with pumps, tanks, hoses, nozzles, ladders, generators, or other fire apparatus used to transport fire personnel, fight fires, and respond to emergencies.
