**A BILL FOR**

1 An Act relating to reports to be submitted by superintendents of  
2 correctional institutions to the director of the department of  
3 corrections.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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1 Section 1. Section 246.307, Code 1987, is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3 246.307 ANNUAL REPORTS.

4 The superintendent of each institution shall make an annual  
5 report to the director. ~~The report shall include a detailed  
6 and accurate inventory of the stock and supplies on hand, and  
7 their amount and value.~~

8 Sec. 2. Section 246.311, Code 1987, is amended to read as  
9 follows:

10 246.311 CONTINGENT FUND.

11 The director may permit the superintendent of each  
12 institution to retain a stated amount of funds in possession  
13 as a contingent fund for the payment of freight, postage,  
14 commodities purchased on authority of the director on a cash  
15 basis, salaries, inmate allowances, and bills granting  
16 discount for cash. If necessary, the director shall make  
17 proper requisition upon the director of revenue and finance  
18 for a warrant on the treasurer of state to secure the  
19 contingent fund for each institution. ~~A monthly report of the  
20 status of the contingent fund shall be submitted by the  
21 superintendent of the institution to the director, according  
22 to rules prescribed by the director.~~

23 EXPLANATION

24 This bill affects the contents of certain reports required  
25 to be filed by superintendents of correctional institutions to  
26 the director of the department of corrections. The  
27 requirement that the annual report include a detailed  
28 inventory of supplies on hand is stricken and the requirement  
29 that a monthly report on the status of the contingency fund be  
30 filed is stricken.
