6 2. Page 1, line 5, by inserting after the figure  
7 "1990" the following: "and each four years  
8 thereafter".

12 EXPLANATION

13 The bill provides that if the proposed constitutional  
14 amendment providing for the governor and lieutenant governor  
15 to run as a team is approved by the qualified electors in the  
16 1988 general election, for the 1990 general election, the  
17 lieutenant governor shall be nominated by the state convention  
18 of each of the political parties. Nonparty political  
19 organizations are directed to nominate their candidates for  
20 lieutenant governor for the 1990 general election in the same  
21 manner that these organizations normally nominate their  
22 candidates.
