

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS IN PUBLIC SERVICE JOBS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 15.227, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code 1987. is amended to read as follows:

a. A person participating in the "young adult program" shall be between the ages of mineteen <u>eighteen</u> and twenty-four at the time of entry into the program, possess work skills at or above a minimum level prescribed by the regulating authority, and be an unemployed resident of a-county-which-is classified-as-economically-distressed-in-accordance-with standards-adopted-by-the-regulating-authority the state.
