RELATING TO THE EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS IN PUBLIC SERVICE JOBS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

I hereby certify that this bill originated in the House and is known as House File 379, Seventy-second General Assembly.

Section 1. Section 15.227, subsection 1, paragraph a, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

a. A person participating in the "young adult program" shall be between the ages of ~~nineteen~~ eighteen and twenty-four at the time of entry into the program, possess work skills at or above a minimum level prescribed by the regulating authority, and be an unemployed resident of ~~a county which is classified as economically distressed in accordance with standards adopted by the regulating authority~~ the state.

Sec. 2. Section 15.108, subsection 6, paragraph d, Code 1987, is amended by striking the paragraph.
