

AN ACT RELATING TO THE CONTRACTING OF INDEBTEDNESS FOR COUNTY CONSER-VATION PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 331.478, subsection 2, paragraph h, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

h. Expenditures for land acquisition <u>and capital</u> <u>improvements</u> for county conservation purposes not to exceed in any year the conetary equivalent of a tax of six and threeI hereby certify that this bill originated in the House and is known as House File 380, Seventy-second General Assembly.
