1 An Act to authorize the parties to a dissolution to waive the
2 filing of a financial statement only after approval by the
3 court.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

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HF 408

1 Section 1. Section 598.13, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code
2 1987, is amended to read as follows:

3 Both parties shall disclose their financial status. A
4 showing of special circumstances shall not be required before
5 the disclosure is ordered. A statement of net worth set forth
6 by affidavit on a form prescribed by the supreme court and
7 furnished without charge by the clerk of the district court
8 shall be filed by each party prior to the dissolution hearing,
9 unless-waived-by-both-parties. However, the parties may waive
10 this requirement upon application of both parties and approval
11 by the court.

12 EXPLANATION

13 This bill authorizes the parties to a dissolution to waive
14 the filing of a financial statement only after approval by the
15 court. Presently, approval of the court is not required.

AN ACT

TO AUTHORIZE THE PARTIES TO A DISSOLUTION TO WAIVE THE FILING OF A FINANCIAL STATEMENT ONLY AFTER APPROVAL BY THE COURT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 598.13, unnumbered paragraph 1, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

Both parties shall disclose their financial status. A showing of special circumstances shall not be required before the disclosure is ordered. A statement of net worth set forth by affidavit on a form prescribed by the supreme court and furnished without charge by the clerk of the district court shall be filed by each party prior to the dissolution hearing, unless waived by both parties. However, the parties may waive
