1 Section 1. Section 109.55, Code 1987, is amended by adding
2 the following new unnumbered paragraph:

3 NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. Section 109.50 and this section

6 The number of game of a game species protected by this chapter
7 which are donated by a person to a nonprofit corporation plus

11 EXPLANATION

12 This bill provides that a prohibition on the sale of
13 protected game does not apply to game sold by a nonprofit
14 corporation as a part of a meal. The bill also provides that
15 the number of game of a game species donated to a nonprofit
16 corporation by a person plus any additional game of the same
17 species in the person's possession must not exceed the
18 person's legal possession limit.

RELATING TO THE RECEIPT AND SALE OF PROTECTED GAME, FUR-BEARING

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 109.55, Code 1987, is amended by adding the following new unnumbered paragraph:

NEW UNNUMBERED PARAGRAPH. Section 109.50 and this section do not apply to a game species, fur-bearing animal species, or variety of fish protected under this chapter which is sold by a nonprofit corporation as a part of a meal. The number of game of a game species or fur-bearing animal species, or a variety of fish protected by this chapter which are donated by a person to a nonprofit corporation plus any additional game of the same species or same variety of fish in the person's
