BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 602.1303, subsection 1, Code 1987, is amended by adding the following new lettered paragraph after paragraph a and by relettering the subsequent paragraph:

NEW LETTERED PARAGRAPH. b. The counties within the judicial districts shall provide suitable offices and other physical facilities for the district court administrator and staff at locations within the judicial districts determined by the chief judge of the respective judicial districts. The county auditor of the host county shall apportion the costs of providing the offices and other physical facilities among the counties within the judicial district in the proportion that
