1 Section 1. Section 321.115, Code 1987, is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3 321.115 ANTIQUATED ANTIQUE VEHICLES.

4 1. Any A motor vehicle twenty-five years old, or older,  
5 whose owner desires to use said the motor vehicle exclusively  
6 for exhibition or educational purposes at state or county  
7 fairs, or other places where said the motor vehicle may be  
8 exhibited for entertainment or educational purposes, shall be  
9 given a registration permitting the driving of said the motor  
10 vehicle upon the public roads to and from said fair or other  
11 place of entertainment or education for a registration fee of  
12 five dollars per annum.

13 2. The sale of a motor vehicle twenty-five years old or  
14 older which is primarily of value as a collector's item and  
15 not as transportation is not subject to chapter 322 and any  
16 person may sell such a vehicle at retail or wholesale without  
17 a license as required under chapter 322.

18 3. The owner of a motor vehicle, which is twenty-five  
19 years old or older, may submit for approval by the department  
20 a vintage but expired set of official Iowa registration plates  
21 which is twenty-five years old or older. Upon approval of the  
22 vintage registration plates by the department, the owner shall  
23 be issued an annual registration decal which shall be affixed  
24 to the motor vehicle in accordance with rules adopted by the  
25 department. The vintage registration plates shall be  
26 displayed in the same manner as regular registration plates.  
27 The annual fee for use of vintage registration plates shall be  
28 ten dollars which is in addition to the regular annual  
29 registration fee. A motor vehicle which has vintage  
30 registration plates registered for its use under this  
31 subsection is not eligible for the special registration fee  
32 under subsection 1.

#### EXPLANATION

34 This bill allows owners of motor vehicles, which are  
35 twenty-five years old or older, to submit sets of vintage but

1 expired official Iowa registration plates for approval by the  
2 state department of transportation. Upon approval of the  
3 vintage registration plates, the owners are issued annual  
4 registration decals to be affixed to the vehicles. The fee  
5 for the use of vintage registration plates is ten dollars  
6 which is in addition to the regular annual registration fee.

7 The bill is similar to Oklahoma law which allows the use of  
8 such plates.

321.115 ANTIQUATED ANTIQUE VEHICLES.

1. Any A motor vehicle twenty-five years old or older, whose owner desires to use said the motor vehicle exclusively for exhibition or educational purposes at state or county fairs, or other places where said the motor vehicle may be exhibited for entertainment or educational purposes, shall be given a registration for a registration fee of five dollars per annum permitting the driving of said the motor vehicle upon the public roads to and from said-fair state and county fairs or other place places of entertainment or education for a-registration-fee-of-five-dollars-per-annum for exhibition or educational purposes and to and from service stations for the purpose of receiving necessary maintenance.
