3 90A.10 MAXIMUM AGE FOR PARTICIPANTS -- AMATEUR BOXING.

6 each contestant participating in the contest is over the age
7 of thirty. A birth certificate, or other similar document,

14 EXPLANATION

15 This bill provides exceptions to the requirement that a

19 competition and competition involving military boxers.

AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MAXIMUM AGE FOR PARTICIPATION IN AN ORGANIZED
AMATEUR BOXING CONTEST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 90A.10, Code 1987, is amended to read
as follows:

90A.10 MAXIMUM AGE FOR PARTICIPANTS -- AMATEUR BOXING.

1. A person over the age of thirty shall not participate
as a contestant in an organized amateur boxing contest unless
each contestant participating in the contest is over the age
of thirty. A birth certificate, or other similar document,
must be submitted at the time of the preflight physical
examination in order to determine eligibility.

2. Subsection 1 does not apply to participants in
regional, national, or international organized amateur boxing
