7 EXPLANATION

8 This bill provides that community work assignments, as well  
9 as work assignments of value to the state or the public, are  
10 covered by the state tort liability provisions of chapter 25A  
11 when performed by juveniles in connection with dispositions  
12 handed down by the juvenile court.
