3 NEW SUBSECTION. 18. "Intermediate care facility for the

7 NEW SUBSECTION. 19. "Mental illness" means a substantial
8 disorder of thought or mood which significantly impairs
9 judgment, behavior, or the capacity to recognize reality or
10 the ability to cope with the ordinary demands of life. Mental
11 disorders include the organic and functional psychoses,
12 neuroses, personality disorders, alcoholism and drug
13 dependence, behavioral disorders, and other mental disorders
14 as defined by the American psychiatric association diagnostic
15 and statistical manual of mental disorders.

EXPLANATION

32 This bill defines the term "intermediate care facility for
33 the mentally ill" as an intermediate care facility which
34 provides services to individuals with mental illness. The
35 bill also exempts such a facility from the definition of a

1 nursing home for purposes of licensure of a nursing home
2 administrator. The bill provides that the department of
3 inspections and appeals is responsible for rules for nursing
4 homes.

"Nursing home" means any an institution or facility, or part thereof, licensed as an intermediate care facility or a skilled nursing facility, but not including an intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded or an intermediate care facility for the mentally ill, defined as such for licensing purposes under state law or pursuant to the rules and regulations for nursing homes established promulgated by the Iowa department of public state board of health, in consultation with the department of inspections and appeals, whether proprietary or nonprofit, including but not limited to, nursing homes owned or administered by the federal or
