1 Section 1. Section 17.22, Code 1987, is amended to read as
2 follows:

3 17.22 PRICE.

4 The publications listed in this section shall be sold at a
5 price to be established by ~~dividing-the-total-cost-of the~~
6 legislative council. In determining these prices, the
7 legislative council shall consider the costs of printing,
8 binding, distribution, and paper stock by-the-total-number
9 printed-of-each-edition, and-increasing-the-figure-obtained-by
10 an-amount,-which-represents-all-or-any-portion-of compilation
11 and editing labor costs,-to-be-determined-by-the-legislative
12 council-in-consultation-with-the-state-printer. The
13 legislative council shall also consider the number of volumes
14 to be printed, sold, and distributed in the determination of
15 these prices.

16 EXPLANATION

17 This bill provides that the pricing of the Code of Iowa and
18 related publications are to be determined solely by the
19 legislative council. It also provides guidelines for the
20 legislative council to use in determining these prices.

RELATING TO THE PRICING OF THE CODE OF IOWA AND RELATED PUBLICATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 17.22, Code 1987, is amended to read as follows:

17.22 PRICE.

The publications listed in this section shall be sold at a price to be established by ~~dividing the total cost of the legislative council~~ In determining these prices, the legislative council shall consider the costs of printing, binding, distribution, and paper stock by the total number printed of each edition, and increasing the figure obtained by an amount which represents all or any portion of compilation and editing labor costs, to be determined by the legislative council in consultation with the state printer. The legislative council shall also consider the number of volumes
