5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

1 Section 1. Section 25A.14, Code 1987, is amended by adding
2 the following new subsection:

3 NEW SUBSECTION. 12. Any claim based upon the actions of a
4 care review committee member in the performance of duty if the
5 action is undertaken and carried out in good faith.

6 Sec. 2. Section 135C.25, Code 1987, is amended by adding
7 the following new subsection:

8 NEW SUBSECTION. 3. Neither the state nor any care review
9 committee member is liable for an action by a care review
10 committee member in the performance of duty, if the action is
11 undertaken and carried out in good faith.

12 Sec. 3. Section 249D.44, Code 1987, is amended by adding

14 NEW SUBSECTION. 3. Neither the state nor any care review
15 committee member is liable for an action undertaken by a care

18 EXPLANATION

19 This bill provides that neither the state nor a care review
20 committee member is liable for an action of a care review
21 committee member if the action is executed in good faith while

RELATING TO THE EXEMPTION FROM LIABILITY OF CARE REVIEW COMMITTEE MEMBERS AND THE STATE CONCERNING ACTIONS UNDERTAKEN BY CARE REVIEW COMMITTEE MEMBERS IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THEIR DUTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. Section 25A.14, Code 1987, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 12. Any claim based upon the actions of a care review committee member in the performance of duty if the action is undertaken and carried out in good faith.

Sec. 2. Section 135C.25, Code 1987, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 3. Neither the state nor any care review committee member is liable for an action by a care review committee member in the performance of duty, if the action is undertaken and carried out in good faith.

Sec. 3. Section 249D.44, Code 1987, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

NEW SUBSECTION. 3. Neither the state nor any care review committee member is liable for an action undertaken by a care
